



Regional Smart Survey Manager Level Training, MARCH, JULY AND OCTOBER 2019

SMART (Standardized Monitoring and Assessment of Relief and Transitions) is an inter-agency initiative, which was launched in 2002 by a network of organizations and humanitarian practitioners, including donors, policymakers, and leading experts in emergency epidemiology, nutrition, food security, early warning systems, and demography. SMART is widely accepted by the Global Nutrition Cluster (GNC) and Action Against Hunger has acted as the SMART Project Convener since 2009.

SMART was initiated to improve the monitoring, reporting and evaluation of humanitarian interventions. It has been designed to address issues of common interest to many organizations working in humanitarian assistance including the need to: i) standardize survey methodologies among organizations, ii) strengthen the technical capacity of all partners with user-friendly tools; and iii) establish comprehensive, collaborative systems to ensure good quality and reliable data is used for reporting and decision-making.

Over the past ten years, the SMART methodology has grown to become the reference and universal tool used amongst nutrition stakeholders in all settings (development, emergency, displaced populations) to assess the prevalence of malnutrition and its determining factors and conduct trend analyses.

An inter-agency SMART Survey Manager Level Trainings will be organized by the **SMART Team at Action Against Hunger – Canada** and **Amref International University** for the following dates:

Cycle 1: 26th March – 2nd April, 2019

Cycle 2: 2nd – 9th July, 2019

Cycle 3: 1st – 8th October, 2019

This training will be hosted by **AMREF International University**. This training is intended for staff or persons involved in nutrition and mortality surveys in their agencies. Persons who will benefit from this workshop are:

1. Persons from organizations/institutions directly responsible for the planning, supervision and /or data analysis of nutritional surveys
2. Persons from organizations/institutions with experience in conducting nutritional surveys, but who need to improve their capacity using SMART Methodology
3. Persons with a basic understanding of malnutrition and statistical principles.

In this SMART Survey Manager Training, you will gain knowledge in how to define survey objectives, determine sample size & sampling strategy, recruit and train survey teams, supervise field teams, assess data quality, interpret results and formulate recommendations

A training fee of **USD \$ 1,600** per participant will apply for the 7-day survey manager training. The training fees will cover all classroom instructions, practical exercises, training material and catering for the duration of the training.
