1. Job Description

The holder of the job will lead the curriculum development and delivery in rehabilitative medicine including physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, art/drama therapy and related disciplines. Further, the holder will develop, and implement research and extension activities.

2. Main Duties and Key Responsibilities

- Coordinate (participate in) the development of curricular in rehabilitative medicine
- Lead (participate in) accreditation and implementation of courses as per CUE guidelines
- Teach and supervise students
- Coordinate practicum
- Develop and carry out research activities
- Form and manage partnerships for advancing psychology and psychotherapy
- Mobilize resources to ensure sustainability of courses in rehabilitative medicine
- Develop and apply innovative and appropriate teaching techniques and material which create interest, understanding and enthusiasm amongst students.

3. Academic requirements

- An earned PhD (ongoing PhD candidates) in Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, art/drama therapy or related field from a recognized university.
- Three (3) years teaching experience in a recognized university or similar relevant research/industry experience for the position of Lecturer.
- Publications - at least twenty four (24) publication points for the position of Lecturer.
- Registered with relevant professional body
