8. Mark, grade and enter the grades into ERP for the assigned units;
9. Supervise trainees on industrial attachment;
10. Prepare trainees for external exams by providing practical technical skills as required for effective competency acquisition;
11. Maintaining appropriate records and making them available as required by the directorate and TVET CDACC or any other relevant body;
12. Adhere to the exam preparation and processing schedule;
13. Attendance to all class contact hours as assigned.
