Course overview

Globally, there is a significant burden, suffering and deaths associated with sexual and reproductive health problems. Diseases related to sexuality and reproduction account for 20% of the disease burden for women and 15 % for men. These are independent of sexual dysfunctions which are estimated to affect 30% of men and 20% of women at any given time, compromising their quality of life and productivity.

Goal of the Programme

The overall goal of the programme is to equip the learner with knowledge, skills and competencies to be able to integrate human sexuality, sexual and reproductive health and related rights from international, regional and domestic perspectives into programming, policy advocacy and research for socio-economic development.

Learning Outcomes

- Apply knowledge of human sexuality, reproductive health and related rights, based on global perspectives to develop evidence-based interventions to improve the well-being of the most vulnerable populations
- Analyse policies and legal frameworks addressing sexual and reproductive health and related rights
- Apply knowledge of socio-cultural contexts to identify strategic interventions for sexual and reproductive health and related rights
- Analyze the role of international and regional policy frameworks in addressing sexual and reproductive health and related rights

Admission Requirements

Candidates eligible for admission to the MSRHRP degree programme shall be holders of:

- Relevant Bachelor's degree recognized by Amref International University (AMIU) **OR**
- Any other qualification recognized by Amref International University (AMIU)



Duration of the Programme:
