- Conduct field surveys using Kobo Toolbox on mobile devices or tablets.
- Facilitate in-depth interviews, focus groups, and key informant interviews.
- Accurately record and securely store interview data, including audio files and transcripts.
- Organize and code qualitative data for analysis.
- Build rapport with participants and ensure informed consent is obtained.
- Adhere to ethical guidelines and maintain participant confidentiality.

- Support the research team in refining data collection methods and tools.
- Assist in the preparation of research findings for presentations or publications.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in health sciences, statistics, or social sciences.
- Strong computer skills
- At least one year of experience in research fieldwork, including data collection and analysis.
- Familiarity with data analysis tools like R, Stata, or Atlas.ti.
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Ability to work independently and manage multiple tasks under tight deadlines.
- Applicants must be under 35 years old and based in Nairobi or Nakuru.
