Background

Scholarship Package

The scholarship will cover tuition, stipend, research thesis, conference presentations and publications.

Eligibility Criteria

The following eligibility criteria will apply:

- Should meet the admission requirements for the respective postgraduate programme of Amref International University being applied for <https://admissions.amref.ac.ke>
- Available for the January 2026 intake
- Be a citizen and resident of Kenya or Zambia
- Be 35 years or below at the time of application - but there will be special considerations for applicants slightly above 35 years, including: young women, displaced persons (refugees & internally displaced persons), persons with disabilities, unemployed and socio-economically disadvantaged applicants

How to Apply

1. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the respective postgraduate program at Amref International University and are required to apply for admission in order to be considered for the scholarship.  - a. Cover Letter (not more than 500 words) detailing motivation for applying for the course

- b. Certified copies of academic certificates and transcripts (from university & high school)
- c. A 1,000-word proposed research project concept in the field of interest
- d. Two reference letters from a recent institution of learning and/ or workplace/ internship
- e. Copy of passport (personal details page) or National Identification (ID) card
- f. Electronic clear coloured passport size photograph (2cm x 2cm, Format - jpg, png, tiff)
- g. An updated Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- h. Proof of socio-economic disadvantage (letter from a community administrator)
- i. Refugee identification document (where applicable)
- j. Disability registration document (where applicable)
- k. Letter from the relevant government authority stating the reason and nature of displacement (where applicable)

Guidelines for submitting the online scholarship application form

- Prepare all the required supporting documents in advance in the recommended format.
- Save all documents as PDF files, except for the passport-size photograph, which should be in JPG, PNG, or TIFF format.
- Name each file clearly using the format: Your Full Name – Document Name
