



AMIU UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR GHANAIAN STUDENTS – SEPTEMBER 2026 INTAKE

Amref International University (AMIU) invites applications for undergraduate scholarships from eligible students seeking to pursue Bachelor's degree programmes at the University.

The scholarship is intended to support academically strong students from financially disadvantaged backgrounds who demonstrate the potential to succeed in higher education but may face challenges in meeting the cost of university education.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be applying for admission to, or be admitted to, a Bachelor's degree programme at Amref International University (AMIU).
- Demonstrate genuine financial need and inability to adequately meet the cost of university education without financial assistance.
- Have demonstrated strong academic performance in high school.
- Have completed high school in 2025.
- Provide accurate and complete information and supporting documentation as required during the application process.
- Be willing to comply with the terms and conditions of the AMIU Scholarship Programme.

Application Instructions

Before applying for the scholarship, applicants must have applied for a Bachelor's degree programme at Amref International University (AMIU).

Applicants should:

1. Apply for admission to AMIU for a Bachelor's degree programme if they have not already done so.
2. Obtain their AMIU admission letter, which will be required when completing the scholarship application.
3. Complete all sections of the AMIU Undergraduate Scholarship Application Form accurately and truthfully.
4. Provide the required information and supporting documents relating to their academic performance and financial circumstances.

5. Review the information provided before submitting the application to ensure that all details are accurate and complete.
6. Submit the scholarship application within the specified application period. The deadline for submission is 26th August 2026.

Important: Applying for an AMIU Bachelor's degree programme does not automatically constitute an application for the scholarship. Applicants must separately complete and submit this scholarship application form to be considered for scholarship support.

Applicants who have not applied for a Bachelor's programme at AMIU will not be eligible for consideration for this scholarship.

Applicants will be assessed based on academic merit, demonstrated financial need, and the overall strength of their application. Meeting the minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee the award of a scholarship, as scholarships are limited and awarded competitively.

Applicants are encouraged to provide clear and accurate information about their academic background, family and financial circumstances, and any other information that may assist the University in assessing their eligibility.

Important: Only applications that are complete and submitted within the specified application period will be considered.
